DAY 1 | TRIESTE – OPATIJA

Welcome Dinner with Fado Review

Private car/van transfer from Trieste Ronchi dei Legionari Airport to Opatija, a historic seaside resort where in the 19th century the first hotel on the Adriatic coast was built and noble families from Austro-Hungarian Monarch used to spend their winters. Opatija is still today one of the most prominent resorts in the region with beautiful hotels in historic buildings, Lungomare promenade and many Viennese style cafes with the view to the sea. Overnight in Opatija.

DAY 2 | OPATIJA – ISTRIA – PULA – ROVINJ – POREC – OPATIJA

Breakfast

After buffet breakfast at the hotel, enjoy a full day excursion to Istria. Visit of Pula, today the biggest city in Istria. It is built around the impressive Roman Amphitheater from 1st century AD. Continue to Rovinj, one of Istria's most beautiful coastal cities. Head to Porec, with its amazing Euphrasius Basilica, a UNESCO World Heritage Site from the 6th century. Here you will literally walk on layers of history! Evening return to Opatija.

DAY 3 | OPATIJA – ZADAR – SIBENIK – SPLIT

Breakfast

Buffet breakfast at the hotel and check out. Departure to Zadar, a town that is renowned for its amazingly rich history and splendid sunsets! Here you will have opportunity to enjoy the sound of "The Sea Organ", music played by the sea. On the way to Split we make a short stop in Šibenik to visit the amazing Cathedral, a UNESCO World Heritage Site from the 15th century. We arrive in Split in the late afternoon. Check in and room assignment. Overnight.

DAY 4 | SPLIT – TROGIR – SPLIT

Breakfast

After a leisurely buffet breakfast, depart for a morning sightseeing of this beautiful Dalmatian city with the famous Diocletian Palace, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, a unique monument of Roman architecture from the 3rd century. In the afternoon depart for a guided sightseeing tour of Trogir, a preserved old town, known for its mix of Renaissance, baroque and Romanesque buildings. The town is situated on a small island connected to the mainland by bridges. The 13th-century Cathedral of St. Lawrence houses the Renaissance Chapel of St. John and offers sweeping views from its bell tower, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Afternoon return to Split.

DAY 5 | SPLIT – BRAC ISLAND – HVAR ISLAND

Breakfast

Buffet breakfast at the hotel and check out. Transfer by ferry boat from Split to Brač Island. Enjoy a guided visit of this picturesque Mediterranean island. Visit Škrip, the oldest place on the island and of the stone masonry school in Pušća, the last one in this part of Europe. The stones sculpted from Brač Island have been used to build many well-known world structures, such as the Palace of Diocletian in Split, the Cathedrals in Šibenik and Trogir, the Parliament Houses in Vienna and Budapest, as well as parts of The White House in Washington D.C. Early evening private transfer by speed boat from Bol to Hvar Island. Check in and room assignment.

DAY 6 | HVAR ISLAND

Breakfast ☞ Optional Wine Tour

Buffet breakfast at the hotel. Enjoy a full day on the beautiful Island of Hvar. This morning depart for a guided walking tour of the historic center with St. Stephen's Square, the largest piazza in Dalmatia, the 16th century St. Stephen's Cathedral, the 17th century arsenal, as well as the home to the Croatia's first theatre. Above the town, perhaps visit the impressive Fortica Fortress to take in the beautiful overview of the town and Paklinski Islands. Afternoon is at leisure, however we can arrange an optional half day wine tour of the island if desired. Overnight at hotel.

DAY 7 | HVAR ISLAND – KORKULA ISLAND – OREBIC - DUBROVNIK

Breakfast ☞ Winery Visit & Wine Tasting

Buffet breakfast at the hotel and check out. Transfer to the port and embark on a morning catamaran ride from Hvar to Korčula. Disembark and enjoy guided sightseeing of Korčula's town with its curvy alleys and stone walls, also known as the birthplace of the great explorer, Marco Polo. In the afternoon embark on a ferry ride to Orebic on the Peljesac Peninsula known for its exceptional wines. Stop for a winery visit, wine tasting at the renowned Grgich Winery, owned by a Croatian-born Californian wine-maker from Napa Valley, the Grgich Hills Estate. We continue to the pearl of the Adriatic, Dubrovnik. Check in and room assignment. Overnight.

DAY 8 | DUBROVNIK

Breakfast ☞ Optional City Walls Stroll, Funicular Ride, Lokrum Island Cruise

Enjoy a relaxing buffet breakfast at the hotel before departing for a guided sightseeing tour of Dubrovnik, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. The city is surrounded by 2 kilometers of walls with towers built between 11th and 17th centuries. Walk along the city's main street, Stradun, visit to the Rector's Palace, St. Vlaho Church, the Cathedral, the Franciscan Monastery, home to one of the oldest pharmacies in Europe from the 14th century. Afternoon at leisure in Dubrovnik, or join an optional guided afternoon stroll along the city walls, funicular ride to the Srđ Hill above Dubrovnik or a scenic boat excursion to Lokrum Island. Overnight in Dubrovnik.

DAY 9 | DUBROVNIK – USA

Breakfast

Buffet breakfast at the hotel and check out. Private car/van transfer to Dubrovnik's Cilipi Airport for your return flight home, or extend your stay! Doviđenja!
